### **Course Objective:**

This presentation will provide an update on clinical practice guidelines in the management of PTSD. The epidemiology of trauma will be discussed along with its biopsychosocial impact on the body, mind, and soul. Recognizing that individual, trauma-specific psychotherapies have emerged as first-line treatment for PTSD, we will discuss the need for mental health care delivery systems entrenched in the traditional "group + med management" paradigm to shift to evidence-based approaches.

She continues to teach medical students as Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Science at Texas A&M Health Science Center-College of Medicine in Round Rock, Texas.

Dr. Arlinghaus' academic interests include the neuropsychiatry of traumatic brain injury, mind-body medicine, and the impact of trauma on mental and physical health.
