- Early onset Alzheimer's/dementia with behavior disturbances/psychosis
- Bipolar disorder
- Schizophrenia
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Suicidal ideation/attempt; intent/behaviors

Medical Services

Aging adults have different medical needs than other populations, which is why we make sure that the patients in the Evergreen Walk program have access to certain medical services, such as:

- Certified nursing assistants (CNAs)
- Stage I & Stage II wound care
- Help with daily living activities
- Ability to bring a personal CPAP or BiPAP if needed

We accept adults who have a range of mobility needs, including those who use a cane, walker, or wheelchair.

Admissions Criteria

To receive care in the Evergreen Walk program, patients must be able to feed and care for themselves and must not need a cardiac monitor, continuous oxygen, or an IV infusion.

Assessment Options

We are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week to provide a free assessment performed by a master's-level clinician or a registered nurse. Our assessments are offered in an in-person format.

Potential patients can access a detailed in-person assessment via:

- Walk-in visit or scheduled appointment
- Transfer from an ER or another facility
