Medical services

Aging adults have different medical needs than other populations do, which is why we make sure that our older patients have access to certain medical services, such as:

- Care for preexisting conditions
- CPAP machine if needed
- Help with daily living activities
- O₂ 1-2 L/Min
- Wound care

We accept adults who have a range of mobility needs, including those who use a cane, walker or wheelchair.

Admissions criteria

Potential patients must be a danger to themselves or others, experiencing self-deterioration, or in need of opioid or alcohol detoxification to qualify for our inpatient services. Those who receive care in our inpatient program must be able to feed and care for themselves and must not need a cardiac monitor or an IV infusion.
